Job Description

Under general, direction and with wide latitude for the exercise of independent initiative and judgment, the selected candidate will perform more complex and responsible work in the development of computer programs and applications, including coding programming instructions, documenting computer systems programming, testing, and maintaining all mobile applications for the Customer Information Systems Unit within the Office of Information Technology (OIT). The iOS Programmer Analyst will be responsible for the following: working with the business community ensuring that programming specifications meet their requirements; assisting in the development and implementation of all iOS Applications; and supporting all existing iOS Applications for Customer Service/OIT.

Qualification Requirements

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college, including or supplemented by twenty- four (24) semester credits in computer science or a related computer field; *or*
2. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and three years of satisfactory full-time computer programming experience; *or*
3. Education and/or experience equivalent to "1" or "2" above. College education may be substituted for up to two years of the required experience in "2" above on the basis that sixty (60) semester credits from an accredited college is equated to one year experience. In addition, twenty-four (24) credits from an accredited college or graduate school in computer science or a related computer field, or a certificate of at least 625 hours in computer programming from an accredited technical school (post high school), may be substituted for one year of experience. However, all candidates must have at least a four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent.

Essential Skills

The selected candidate must possess the following: Comprehensive practical experience with iOS, Objective C or Cocoa Touch, Photoshop, Google Calendar, Google map, and XML, integrating mobile applications with existing web applications and databases, fundamentals in object-oriented design, data structures, algorithm design, problem solving, and complexity analysis, proficiency in at least one modern object-oriented language such as Objective C (preferred), C++, or C#. Experience building iPhone Apps which have been successfully implemented
