Job Description

Working in the Division of Water Quality Operations, Field Operations Section, Lefrak Office, reporting directly to the Deputy Chief of Field Operations, the selected candidate will be responsible for developing new controlled documents and reviewing and modifying all existing controlled documents for field monitoring, verification and instrumentation; assisting in the control of all pertinent field documents as per Quality Assurance standards; performing analytical investigations and data analyses; recording results of analyses and/or investigations; reviewing data and submitting written reports, including verification of field data from barcode scanner and field meters; performing routine preventative maintenance and repair on all field instrumentation for accurate water quality monitoring including accuracy checks of field instrumentation and reagents, preventative maintenance and repair on auto samplers, and calibrations of all field instrumentation as per controlled documents; providing training in correct sampling technique and usage of field instrumentation for water quality monitoring, including creation of training modules for new and/or existing field procedures; and maintaining proper training records. **This position involves working a rotating five (5) day work week schedule, including weekends.**

Qualification Requirements

A master's degree from an accredited college in one of the following areas of study: environmental or chemical engineering, limnology, environmental science, marine science, geology, biology, earth science, chemistry, physics, or health science; *or*

A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college with 24 semester credits in one or a combination of the areas of study described in paragraph "1" above, at least 12 of which must have been in one of these areas of study; and two years of satisfactory full-time experience, which may not have been part of graduate or undergraduate course work, working in the field of water quality planning, management or research or performing environmental laboratory analyses, and/or environmental field sampling of water; *or*

An associate degree from an accredited college including or supplemented by 24 semester credits in one or a combination of the areas of study described in paragraph "1" above, at least 12 of which must have been in one of these areas of study; and at least three years of satisfactory full-time experience as described in paragraph "2" above.

Special Note

A master's degree from an accredited college in one of the areas described in paragraph "1" above may be substituted for up to two years of the required experience.

License Requirement

Candidate must possess a motor vehicle driver license valid in the State of New York. This license must be maintained for the duration of employment.

Only current Civil Service Scientist (Water Ecology) may apply.
