<p>Working in the Eastern Operations Division, Kensico Region, Systems Operations Section of the Bureau of Water Supply, the selected candidate will perform duties related to the operation, maintenance, repair and inspection of water treatment facilities, equipment and lands in the watershed areas, reservoirs, and aqueduct systems of the City of New York and operate motor vehicles, motor powered equipment and perform related work. The selected candidate will be responsible for water treatment and flow control for the Catskill, Delaware or Croton Aqueduct including treatment with chlorine, fluoride, aluminum sulfate and sodium hydroxide; keeping logs of operations, equipment performance, maintenance and water quality, as well as providing reports, performing simple calculations; and tests, maintaining records, and keeping inventory of chemicals, materials and equipment necessary for water treatment and maintenance of equipment.</p>
