**Job Description**

Under direct supervision, the selected candidate will perform the following technical work of varying degrees of difficulty: daily enforcement of grease inspections of food service establishments to enforce the New York City Sewer Use Regulations; write investigative reports on food establishments; alert supervisors of work status and critical problems; take all measurement and calculations to determine the quantity of grease in an existing grease interceptor; assist engineers in the gathering of data and analysis of this data; make schematic drawings of inspected facilities; issue Notices of Violations; may supervise a group of technicians of various levels and review work of subordinates for quantity and quality; and prepare work schedules and progress reports.

**Qualification Requirements**

1. Graduation from an accredited community college or technical institution with a baccalaureate degree in engineering technology; or
2. Graduation from an accredited community college or technical institution with an associate degree in engineering technology, plus two years of full-time paid experience as an engineering technician; *or*
3. High school graduation or evidence of having passed an examination for the high school equivalency diploma or the United States Armed Forces G.E.D. certificate with a score of at least 35 on each of the five tests and an overall score of at least 225 in the examination for the certificate, plus four years of full-time paid experience as an engineering technician; or
4. Experience and/or education which is equivalent to (1), or (2), or (3) *above*.
