Job Description

Working in the Bureau of Water Supply, Watershed Water Quality Operations, Kensico Laboratory, the selected candidate will perform qualitative and quantitative chemical analyses of moderate difficulty on water, wastewater and related samples using New York State (NYS) approved methods and instrumentation (e.g., solids, physicals, alkalinity, fluoride assays, sample extractions, sample digestions, etc.); participate in and coordinate watershed keypoint, drinking water and wastewater sample collections; and perform and coordinate laboratory support functions such as plastic and glassware washing, use of autoclave, maintaining Quality Control (QC) records, operation and maintenance of laboratory equipment, maintenance of program supply inventories and receiving and logging in samples. This position requires weekend and holiday work.

Qualification Requirements

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university, accredited by regional, national, professional, or specialized agencies recognized as accrediting bodies by the U.S. Secretary of Education and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) included or supplemented by 16 semester credits in chemistry and 8 semester credits in any one or a combination of the following areas: chemistry, pharmacology, toxicology, environmental science, forensic science, or other natural science; and one year of full-time satisfactory experience performing chemical or physical analysis in a laboratory; *or*
2. A satisfactory combination of education and/or experience that is equivalent to "1" above. Education may be substituted for experience on the basis of 30 graduate semester credits for one year of experience from an accredited college or university, accredited by regional, national, professional, or specialized agencies recognized as accrediting bodies by the U.S. Secretary of Education and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) in any of the areas of study described in "1" above for one year of experience. However, all candidates must have a baccalaureate degree from an accredited college with the specialized credits as described in "1" above.
