Job Description

Under direct supervision, the selected candidates will perform the following technical work of varying degrees of difficulty: conduct investigations and sampling of industrial firms to verify compliance with applicable standards and prepare reports that substantiate findings; assist in performing investigations of dry weather discharge found during shoreline surveys; identify and outline drainage areas of dry weather discharge using inflow and infiltration (I&I) drawings, sewer maps, and/or other related documents; and perform special investigations of flow studies of NYC's drainage basins.

Qualification Requirements

1. A bachelor's degree in engineering technology from an accredited college or technical institution; *or*
2. An associate degree in engineering technology from an accredited community college, plus two (2) years of full-time satisfactory experience as an engineering technician performing various duties on engineering projects such as: making drawings; preparing specifications and quantity estimates; indexing and filing maps, plans and drawing; gathering, selecting and extracting data; making mathematical and engineering calculations; and performing related technical tasks; *or*
3. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and four years of full-time satisfactory experience as an engineering technician performing various duties on engineering projects as described in "2" above; *or*
4. A satisfactory combination of education and/or experience equivalent to "1", "2" or "3" above. Experience may be substituted for education on the basis that each year of full-time satisfactory experience as described in "2" above is equal to one year (30 semester credits) of college education. However, all candidates must have a minimum of a four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent.

Essential Skills

The selected candidate must possess a driver's license valid in New York State, as this position requires the candidate to travel to different wastewater treatment plants throughout the five boroughs during the work day, some of which are difficult to access by public transportation. Should be proficient in Microsoft Word and Excel.
