Job Description

The New York City Department of Environmental Protection's (DEP) Bureau of Water and Sewer Operations is seeking an experienced Environmental Compliance professional. The selected candidate will be responsible for performing environmental compliance audits, coordinating hazardous waste management programs, regulatory permit compliance, supervising environmental assessment, investigation and remediation projects. Duties will include field activities, preparing project reports, work plans, responding to environmental emergencies, training and regulatory permit applications. The position will require field work, including spill response, for the management of hazardous materials and wastes. This position will require the candidate to interact with field personnel, intra-agency personnel, and regulatory agencies.

Qualification Requirements

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college including, or supplemented by, 28 semester credits in industrial hygiene, environmental health science, occupational health science, and/or safety engineering; *or*
 2. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college including, or supplemented by, 28 semester credits in the physical or natural sciences, civil engineering, mechanical engineering, environmental engineering, chemical engineering and/or toxicology and one year of satisfactory full-time work experience in the identification, evaluation and control of health and safety hazards; *or*
 3. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college and two years of satisfactory full-time work experience as described in "2" above; *or*
 4. A satisfactory combination of education and/or experience which is equivalent to "1", "2" or "3" above. Semester credits from an accredited college in industrial hygiene, environmental health science, occupational health science and/or safety engineering may be substituted for experience on the basis of 7 semester credits equals 6 months experience, up to a maximum of 28 semester credits. Semester credits from an accredited college in the physical or natural sciences, civil engineering, mechanical engineering, environmental engineering, chemical engineering and/or toxicology may be substituted for experience on the basis of 7 semester credits equals 3 months of experience, up to a maximum of 28 semester credits. However, all candidates must have at least a baccalaureate degree from an accredited college.
- License Requirement:** A Motor Vehicle Driver License valid in the State of New York. This license must be maintained for the duration of employment.

Essential Skills

Candidate must be knowledgeable in one or more areas of environmental laws and regulations, such as Federal RCRA, CERCLA/SARA, TSCA, Clean Water Act and Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasure (SPCC) regulations; NYS SPDES, PBS and CBS regulations; and/or NYSDEC requirements for environmental site investigations and remediation. Candidate should have a working knowledge of Microsoft Office software and excellent communication and organization skills.
