Job Description

The Green Infrastructure Unit is a program within the Parks Department that is a partnering with the Department of Environmental Protection's (DEP) Office of Green Infrastructure. Our work focuses on stormwater capture in priority Combined Sewer Overflows (CSO) tributary areas, primarily in the right of way. This partnership not only improves the functioning of the city's sewer system, it transforms grey space into green, providing New Yorkers with all of the commensurate benefits green space performs. The Parks Department's Forestry, Horticulture and Natural Resources division is responsible for citywide urban forestry, ecological and horticulture initiatives, policy standards and performance measures, including street tree planting, Greenstreets, Green Infrastructure, natural areas restoration and horticultural training and education.

Under direction of the Director of Green Infrastructure, the selected candidate will perform responsible supervisory work in green infrastructure and stormwater capture design and construction; supervise the preparation of contract drawings, specifications, stormwater calculations and estimates of quantities for Green Infrastructure and Stormwater Capture projects in collaboration with the DEP; assist in engineering and grading calculations with other staff; monitor progress and prepare reports on design and construction projects, tracking project milestones and budgets; supervise the inspection of grading, planting and other landscaping operations to ensure contract compliance and fulfillment of established landscape architectural practice, standards and DEP; oversee research and development of new Green Infrastructure and stormwater capture specifications and design; coordinate interagency design presentations, approvals and permits for projects with the Department of Transportation, Department of Design and Construction, and DEP; coordinate interagency collaboration where projects overlap and as opportunities afford. Present design plans to Directors, Deputy Chiefs, Chiefs and others; and assist with representing projects to external organizations such as community boards, community interest groups, and other City, State and Federal agencies.

Qualification Requirements

A valid New York State registration as a Landscape Architect and four years of full-time landscape architectural experience. A master's degree in landscape architecture from an accredited college will be accepted as equivalent to one year of full-time landscape architectural experience.

This position is exempt from NYC residency requirements.
