Working in Watershed Water Quality Operations, Kensico Laboratory, under the direction of the Supervisor of Aqueduct Monitoring, the selected candidate will be responsible for performing the following tasks: qualitative and quantitative chemical analyses of moderate difficulty on water, wastewater and related samples using New York State approved methods and instrumentation (e.g., solids, physicals, alkalinity, fluoride assays, sample extractions, turbidity, sample digestion, etc.); participate in and coordinate watershed key point sampling, drinking water and wastewater sample collections; performing and coordinating laboratory support functions such as cleaning plastic and glassware; use of autoclave; maintain Quality Control (QC) records, operate and maintain laboratory equipment; and maintain program supply inventories and receive and log samples. This position requires weekend and holiday work.

Qualification Requirements

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college, including or supplemented by 16 semester credits in chemistry and 8 semester credits in any one or a combination of the following areas: chemistry, pharmacology, toxicology, environmental science, forensic science, or other natural science; and one year of full-time satisfactory experience performing chemical or physical analysis in a laboratory;
or
2. A satisfactory combination of education and/or experience that is equivalent to "1" above. Education may be substituted for experience on the basis of 30 graduate semester credits from an accredited college in any one of the areas of study described in "1" above is equivalent to one year of experience. However, all candidates must have a baccalaureate degree from an accredited college with the specialized credits as described in "1" above.
