Job Description

Working in the Watershed Water Quality Operations Division, under the general direction of the Kensico Laboratory Director, the selected candidate will be responsible for coordinating routine and non-routine sampling programs by subordinate staff in order to meet regulatory compliance requirements; tracking and reporting of water quality data in order to meet daily reporting and regulatory requirements; supervising all phases of sample log-in, sample preparation and labware preparation by subordinate staff; maintaining mandated safety and Quality Assurance/Quality Control (QA/QC) protocols as per the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and New York State (NYS) approved methods, for any field and laboratory determinations performed by subordinate staff; and assisting the laboratory director in all phases concerning the management of the laboratory such as maintaining Surface Water Treatment Rule (SWTR), and meeting New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) Environmental Laboratory Approval Program (ELAP) requirements.

Qualification Requirements

A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college, including or supplemented by 16 semester credits in chemistry and 8 semester credits in any one or a combination of the following areas: chemistry, pharmacology, toxicology, environmental science, forensic science, or other natural science.

In addition, applicants must have at least two years of fulltime satisfactory experience performing chemical or physical analyses in a laboratory.

Education may be substituted for experience as defined in the Special Note below.

Special Note: Education may be substituted for experience on the basis of 30 graduate semester credits from an accredited college in any of the areas of study described in the qualification requirements above for one year of experience. However, all candidates must have a baccalaureate degree from an accredited college with the specialized credits as described above.
