I hereby certify that I am voluntarily requesting a Boat Tag from DEP to allow me to bring and use the boat described herein on/(to) certain property owned by the City of New York (City) for purposes and in a manner as defined by such rules and regulations as are promulgated by the City. I understand that it is my responsibility to know and follow these rules and regulations. I agree to and shall abide by these rules and regulations and further acknowledge that the failure to so abide may result in the immediate revocation of the Boat Tag and prosecution to the fullest extent of the law.

I fully understand the inherent risks, including but not limited to drowning and death from exposure, of using the Property, which is undeveloped and may be unguarded and is used for water supply purposes and may contain lakes, ponds, creeks, streams, reservoirs and other types of watercourses, dams, steep slopes, and other natural or manmade structures.

I understand that the City has no duty to keep the Property safe for entry or use for public access or to give warning of any hazardous condition or use of or structure or activity on the Property pursuant to section 9-103 of the New York State General Obligations Law. I voluntarily and expressly assume any and all risks of personal injury or property damage that might result from my use of the Property, except where such personal injury or property damage is caused by the intentional acts of the City or the willful or malicious failure to guard or to warn against a dangerous condition, use, structure or activity, by the City.

I agree on behalf of myself, my heirs, successors and assigns to voluntarily and fully release, indemnify, and otherwise hold harmless the City and any of its officers, agents, servants, representatives and employees from any and all liability for any personal injury, wrongful death, property loss, property damage, claim or expense of whatsoever nature and description, resulting from any cause whatsoever arising out of my being in, on or about the Property, except where such damage or injury is caused by the intentional acts of the City or the willful or malicious failure to guard or to warn against a dangerous condition, use, structure, or activity, by the City.

I hereby further state that I am the owner of the boat described herein. I understand that this Boat Tag is not transferable and that I must inform DEP within thirty (30) days of any change in ownership of the boat. If the boat is stolen, destroyed, or otherwise rendered useless, I will inform DEP within thirty (30) days of learning such and the Boat Tag shall be cancelled. I understand that I am responsible for having the boat or its remains removed from City property when the boat has been destroyed or otherwise rendered useless.
