

1. Get a DEP Access Permit.
2. Get your watercraft steam cleansed and Recreational Boat Tag at one of our designated vendors.
3. Bring your boat down to the reservoir.
4. Put on your life vest and have fun! Be safe!

Season and Times

- Starts Friday of Memorial Day Weekend and ends Columbus Day
- Sunrise to Sunset
- Runs for three boating seasons – 2009, 2010, 2011
- Temporary passes for 1 to 7 days and full season passes available. Full season passes will require boats to be secured and left on the reservoir.

Types of Boats Permitted

- Non-motorized boats only (*includes no trolling motors*)
- Row boats/Jon boats
- Canoes, Kayaks and Sculls
- Small sailboats (*with removable center/dagger boards*)
Kayaks must be at least 9' in length - all others boats must be at least 11'5" in length

Launch Sites

- 9 launch sites and over 100 vehicle parking spots
- Hand carry in only
- No trailers/vehicles in the water
- Some sites will have handicap parking designated
- Sailboats can only launch at Dry Brook and Roods Creek
- No overnight camping
- Portable privies at most launch sites

Restrictions

- Boats must be steam cleansed and have a cleansing certificate
- No commercial activities without prior approval
- Sailboats can only be used between Trout Creek Bridge and Cannonsville Dam
- No boats permitted within 500 feet of the West Delaware Intake Chamber or the Cannonsville Dam

Why is an area restricted because of eagles?

The Cannonsville area is some of the most important bald eagle habitat in the Northeast. In order to ensure the eagles continue to thrive, it is very important that boaters do not approach eagles or nests. It is against state and federal law to disturb eagles. Enjoy watching the birds from a distance (at least 700') with binoculars or other optics. If the eagles show any signs of unease you are too close! Boat Cleansing

All boats are required to be steam cleansed prior to being placed on the reservoir in order to help prevent the introduction of zebra mussels and other invasive species to the City's reservoirs. Invasive species affect both water supply, infrastructure and water quality and would add millions of dollars to yearly maintenance costs. Steam cleansing and other DEP-approved practices will be continued. In addition to steam cleansing, boats will be inspected for other aquatic nuisance species.

Designated Steam Cleansing Vendors

The vendors listed below the map will be supplying steam cleansing services for a fee, for those wishing to obtain a temporary or seasonal pass. When you visit these locations, please remember to support these local vendors and purchase your supplies from them. Vendors are subject to change. Boat Rentals

Beginning paddlers and visitors can take advantage of the reservoirs waters by renting their preferred craft. Call ahead to reserve your boat. Ask about straps and padding for car-top transportation as well as life vest availability.



