With this letter, I am submitting the following deliverables, due March 31, 2012, pursuant to EPA's July 2007 FAD:



Section 4.6 Stream Management Program, requires DEP to meet annually with contracting partners to re-evaluate Stream Management Program recommendations and establish a modified schedule for actions to be taken. The SMP typically meets with the four county stream management program leaders and staff to review the significant accomplishments of the previous year and discuss priorities for the coming year. In 2012, scheduling this meeting has been very difficult owing to the deadlines associated with the NRCS Emergency Watershed Program as well as the generally increased workload all are carrying in response to Tropical Storms Irene. The teams are currently scheduled to meet on April 6, 2012.

Section 5.1 of the FAD requires DEP to convene an annual meeting of the Pathogen Working Group by March 31. This year's meeting took place on March 29, 2012.
