Section 4.6 Stream Management Program, requires DEP to meet annually with contracting partners to re-evaluate Stream Management Program (SMP) recommendations and establish a modified schedule for actions to be taken. The SMP and its partners have met three times since September 2012 to develop the primary programmatic recommendation post TS Irene - the enhanced flood hazard mitigation aspect of the Stream Management Implementation grants program. The SMP and partners will meet again on April 25th to coordinate the education and outreach effort the partners will use with their municipalities and the public in advancing this high priority program element. The SMP teams are well coordinated at this time.

Section 5.1 of the FAD requires DEP to convene an annual meeting of the Pathogen Working Group by March 31. This year's meeting was scheduled for March 19, 2013; but inclement weather caused a postponement. It has been rescheduled for April 11, 2013.
