<i>Program</i>	<i>Deliverable</i>
<i>4.2 Land Acquisition Program</i>	Submit a methodology, subject to approval, defining what acres solicited under the WAC, Riparian Buffer, and FBO programs will qualify to be counted towards LAP solicitation goals.
<i>4.6 Stream Management Program</i>	Submit a rolling two-year Action Plan for each of the basins that outlines the upcoming projects in the program areas (Stream Projects, CSBI, SMIP, Education/Outreach/Training, and LFHMP).

The Watershed Monitoring Program, section 5.1, is required to coordinate an annual technical Pathogen Working Group meeting. The meeting was held on May 19, 2014.
