With this letter, I am submitting the following deliverables, due July 31, 2014, pursuant to the NYSDOH Revised 2007 Filtration Avoidance Determination (FAD):

On June 11, 2014 the City sent a request to NYSDEC to modify NYC's WSP to allow implementation of a City-funded FBO program. This completes the FAD requirement under section 4.2 Land Acquisition Program.

Section 4.1 of the Revised FAD requires DEP to submit a summary report of the city's Catskill Turbidity Control program. That report was submitted earlier this month, under separate cover.
