

FAD Section 4.9 of the Draft Mid-Term Revisions to the 2007 FAD calls for completion of the three stormwater retrofit sites at Michael Brook (Croton Falls), Sycamore Park (West Branch), and Nemarest Club (Boyd Corner) by October 31, 2013. DEP achieved substantial completion of the three projects on September 18, 2013.

FAD Section 4.10 of the Draft Mid-Term Revisions to the 2007 FAD calls for completion of the Kensico Action Plan pipeline system project in the N7 basin by October 31, 2013. This project will be substantially complete by October 31, 2013.
