Upon receipt of this notice, you are required to complete and/or submit the following within ten days:


1. Obtain the contract books from DEP- Contract Management, 59-17 Junction Blvd., 17th Floor, Flushing NY 11373, Telephone Number 718-595-3597.
2. Sign the appropriate pages in the Agreement Section of all the books. This must be done by an authorized officer of your firm. Where indicated, have then signature **notarized.**
3. Obtain and provide the Performance and Payment Bonds, as required in the Agreement Section, in the amount indicated on Schedule A of the General Conditions. Each contract book shall have its own set of original bonds. **Please provide Surety's phone number.**
4. In accordance with Section 57 of the New York State Workers Compensation Law, the bidder must submit proof of workers compensation and disability benefits coverage to the DEP Contract Management Office prior to the execution of this contract. The evidence of Workers Compensation coverage must be on a form approved by the New York State Workers Compensation Board.
5. **Provide two copies of Certificates of Insurance for all Insurance required by this contract as stated in the Schedule "A". Please provide your broker's name and phone number.**
6. If prevailing wages apply to this contract, you are reminded that it is the City's intention to fully enforce all applicable prevailing wage laws. **This contract is also subject to the Davis Bacon Act and other related federal laws.** Attached is the Davis Bacon Wage Modification to be used for the duration of this contract. The wages to be paid during the performance of this contract are to be at least equal to or greater than the wages listed in this Davis Bacon Wage Modification. You are reminded that your contract and all

subcontractors with a value over \$2,000 are subject to Davis Bacon clauses found in 29 CFR 5.5(a) which requires payment of at least Davis Bacon wages. This contract is also subject to NYC LL220. You and your subcontractors with subcontracts in excess of \$2,000 are required to pay the higher of the wages and benefits as stated in LL220 or the Davis Bacon wages attached.

Submit all of the above to Mr. Don Scoma, at the above location.

An Order to Commence Work letter will be forwarded to you after the contract is registered with the New York City Comptroller's Office.
