

Free Home Water Conservation Kits

Receive a *free* water conservation kit for your home

Currently the New York City Department of Environmental Protection (NYCDEP) is making available **free** water saving kits to private homeowners and individual apartment tenants who live in New York City. These kits contain retrofit fittings such as low-flow showerheads, faucet aerators, and different gravity tank toilet water-saving devices that, if installed and are replacing higher consumption fittings, can reduce water consumption and any associated energy costs. In addition, these kits contain dye tablets used for detecting gravity tank toilet leaks, bags and vials used for measuring shower/faucet flow and/or leak rates, and a host of other items and brochures designed to provide you with everything you need to perform your own Home Water Survey.

This effort is one aspect of an ongoing water conservation program sponsored by the NYCDEP known as the Residential Water Survey Program (RWS). Currently, the City's selected vendor to conduct this program is Honeywell DMC Services.
