Case Recording: Purpose and Skills

Participants in this training learn the purpose—including possible legal uses—of case records, to identify which information should and should not be included in the record, and how to write succinct, meaningful case entries.

Participants in this training learn about different kinds of loss, various theories associated with the grief process and how to work with older people who are struggling with loss and grief.

Anxiety in the Elderly

Anxiety is not a normal part of aging yet it is estimated that the prevalence of anxiety among older adults may be as high as 20%. Participants in this training learn to distinguish between "normal" anxiety and anxiety disorder, what evidenced-based treatment options are available, some strategies and techniques to help clients manage anxiety in the moment, and tips for linking clients with appropriate services.
