


Fiscal Year 2006-2008 Admissions & Average Daily Population

Total Admissions and ADP FY2006-2008 and FYTD




Average Length of Stay Frequencies

Length of Stay of Released Youth





Admissions to Detention by Authority








Top Five Charges at Admission




Admissions by County of Jurisdiction

County of Admission FY06-FY08 & Fiscal Year To Date




Average Daily Population by Case Type



Average Daily Population in Detention by Case Type
