

Local Law 26 of 2004 – Summary of provisions

The Department of Buildings convened the World Trade Center Building Code Task Force in March 2002. The <u>Task Force issued its recommendations</u> in February 2003. <u>Local Law 26 of 2004</u>, signed by Mayor Bloomberg on June 24, 2004, incorporates most of these recommendations by amending the Building Code and Fire Prevention Code. Below is a summary of each of the retroactive and prospective provisions. For more detailed information, please consult the text of Local Law 26 of 2004.
