PIPES/Plumbing Division: New OP-98 Form

A new <u>OP-98 Form</u> (rev. 10/13/05) is currently in effect. This form is used by licensed master plumbers and licensed fire suppression contractors to provide notice and/or results for plumbing, sprinkler and standpipe inspections and/or tests. This form is available online or at our borough offices. After March 1, 2006, ONLY this version of the <u>OP-98 Form</u> will be accepted. All previous form versions will be rejected. See the <u>PIPES/Plumbing Division Service Notice</u> for more details.
