New York City's Newest Park on the West Side's Elevated Rail Structure

On Monday, April 10, 2006, Mayor Bloomberg and Friends of the High Line Co-Founders Robert Hammond and Joshua David hosted a unique groundbreaking ceremony on top of the High Line elevated rail structure, heralding the start of construction of the first phase of New York City's eagerly anticipated park. To mark the occasion, the City's contractors lifted one of the few remaining railroad tracks in the first section of the 1.5-mile-long High Line to be converted to park use. Open Applications and Issuance of Certificate of Occupancy - Pilot Initiative - Expanded Citywide

The Department of Buildings is expanding the Open Applications Initiative pilot program to all five borough offices. The program will consider issuing a final Certificate of Occupancy while allowing certain alteration applications to remain open. The initiative is limited to applications filed with the Department other than those involving base building life safety systems (examples: standpipe, sprinklers, fire alarms and egress, etc.) View the <u>service notice memorandum</u> (50 kb-pdf) for contact information and additional details about the requirements of the program.

New License Exam Format for Site Safety Manager, Elevator Director and Elevator Inspector

Beginning April 18, candidates for the Site Safety Manager certificate, Private Agency Elevator Director license, and Elevator Inspector license will be able to schedule an exam at their convenience (28 kb-pdf). Exams will be available at five computer testing centers throughout the five boroughs weekdays between 9 am and 8 pm.
