Local Law 86 of 2005 - Green Buildings

Local Law 86/2005 is the City's "green buildings law" because it requires new buildings and major alterations to be designed according to LEED standards (see www.USGBC.org for more information on LEED). In addition, it has higher standards for energy and water consumption, depending upon the above project types or other alterations.
