### Buildings Department Releases New Edition of its Code of Conduct

The Department of Buildings released the second edition of its [Code of Conduct](#) (168 kb-pdf). The Code of Conduct, presented in a plain language booklet, details standards for employees' professional behavior. One of the fundamental tenets of the Code is a zero tolerance policy for serious misconduct, criminal and/or corruption-related activities. ### New Expeditor ID

### Photoluminescent Markings Installation Deadline Approaching

Effective July 1, 2006, Photoluminescent Exit Path Markings must be installed in all high rise buildings to aid in emergency evacuations. Once installed, an affidavit that certifies compliance must be submitted to the Buildings Department. By law, both the installation and the affidavit
