New Outdoor Sign Registration Program Begins Friday



In an effort to better regulate existing and new signs near arterial highways and parks, the City of New York has enhanced its sign registration program. Effective August 25th, the Rules of the City of New York Chapter 49 (Rule 49) imposes certain new registration requirements for outdoor advertising companies (OACs). OACs will have 60 days to apply for an OAC registration number and submit their sign inventory. Once approved, the OAC will have 90

days to display the OAC name, OAC registration number and work permit number on all signs. Any OAC that fails to register or violates the sign registration program may be subject to fines of up to \$25,000 per day and the signs may be removed by the City.
