## **New Requirements for Sign Applications**

Local Law 31 of 2005 was enacted to help make New York City an even better place to live, work and build by enhancing the regulations for the installation of signage near arterial highways and parks. Pursuant to RCNY Chapter 49, Subchapter E, (122 kb-pdf) applicants are now required to file a Property Owner Sign Affidavit (SIG-1) and a Sign Restrictive Declaration for certain sign permits.
