### Staten Island To Launch B-SCAN



To make it easier and faster for you to access job filing documents, on April 30, 2007, the Staten Island Borough Office is launching the Building Scan and Capture Application Network (<u>B-SCAN</u>) document

management system. As a major component of the Agency's <u>2006 - 2009 Strategic Plan</u> (2,746 kb-pdf), <u>B-SCAN</u> will scan paper documents received (with the exception of plans), to enable the electronic processing, storage and online retrieval of documents associated with New Building and Alteration applications. ### New Electrical ED-16A Form
