New Standards for Private Road Lighting

Effective May 21, 2007, plans filed for the installation of "private roads," as defined in the Zoning Resolution, in any zoning district must meet new standards. These new requirements do not apply retroactively and will be applicable only to those applications for which plan approvals have not been issued for the installation of the private roads. Did You Know?_____

Did you know that <u>Local Law 52 of 2005</u> (108 kb-pdf) requires individuals who use, erect, maintain, dismantle, repair or modify a supported scaffold to have a Certificate of Completion in a scaffold safety program?
