### IBC to Include NYC's Photoluminescent Regulations



On May 24, 2007, the International Code Council (ICC) membership voted to revise the International Building Code to include New York City's standard requiring the installation of photoluminescent path markings in the stairwells of most new high-rise buildings. New York City was the first major city to adopt regulations requiring the glow-in-the-dark strips to be installed on steps, handrails, and the perimeter of enclosed stairwells in high-rise office buildings when Mayor Bloomberg signed LL 26 of 2004 (171 kb-pdf) two years ago.
