## **Buildings Seeks Qualified Architects and Engineers**

# **Revised PW3 Captures Additional Cost Details**

To better verify the construction cost of any alteration work, the Department has revised the <u>PW3 form</u> to require more detailed information. The form's new version is required at Initial Filing, for all changes affecting costs (including Prior to Approval Actions and Post Approval Amendments), and to obtain sign off. # **Upcoming Revised Electrical Application Form**

To capture more information when filing for an electrical permit, the Department has revised the <u>Electrical Permit Application</u> (ED16A). Beginning September 29, applicants will be required to detail work being done on each floor. View the <u>service notice</u> (35 kb-pdf) for more information.

## **Enhanced Protection for City-Owned Properties**

Information You Need To Know

To protect the integrity of City-owned buildings, <u>a new required item</u> (24 kb-pdf) for Art Commission approval now automatically applies to all applications for proposed work affecting building exteriors on City-owned properties that are not landmarked.

#### **Code Compass: New Codes Rules**



The implementation of the New Codes has generated a number of new rules, several of which were adopted September 2. These new rules pertain to <u>fire alarm wiring</u> (577 kb-pdf), <u>technical standards for masonry equivalent walls</u> (549 kb-pdf), <u>one-way emergency voice</u>

<u>communications systems</u> (551 kb-pdf) and construction standards for <u>impact resistant stair and</u> <u>elevator enclosures</u> (564 kb-pdf). Visit the <u>New Codes Rules</u> section of our website to learn more.

### **General Contractor Insurance Requirement Deadline Approaching**



To ensure work is performed by insured parties, all contractors conducting business with the Department must submit or update their insurance with the <u>Licensing unit</u> by October 31. Those failing to meet this deadline will not be issued permits until the requirement is satisfied. ## **Cranes and Derricks Unit Requires Filing Representative ID**

Filing representatives seeking to conduct business with the <u>Cranes and Derricks unit</u> must <u>register</u> (21 kb-pdf) with the Buildings Department and must obtain a Buildings-issued filing representative identification card. This process includes filling out an application and undergoing a background investigation.
