Revised responses

Please see revised responses to certain questions from Addenda #2.

- 11) Our vendors provide us with supplies, are we allowed to use those vendors?

Revised response: Subcontracting is not allowed. We expect that the awarded vendor will provide all required supplies.

- 15) What is the estimated annual percent of positive test?

Revised Response: Currently, this is less than one percent. However, this shall not serve as a basis to determine future percentage of positive tests.

- 18) I see you require the initial screen use the ELIZA method. Would you consider the EMIT (Enzyme Multiplied Immunoassay Technique) method of testing?

Revised Response: The Department may consider EMIT method in the future. For the purposes of this bid, the ELIZA method is currently specified.

Additional Questions and Responses

1) Can you tell me is subcontract allowed in this contract?

Response: No, subcontracting is not allowed.

2) The contract has to train the DOC?

Response: See training requirements on Part C, Article 4.A.(4) page C-2.

3) We have to pick up the specimen from DOC right?

Response: Yes. See Part C, Article 4.B.(1) and responses to questions 7 and 16 in Addenda #2.

4) on the Immunoglobulin G confirmation test , what are actually you looking for ? blood test to test for alcohol level right ?

Response: Immunoglobulin G confirmation test is a test required on the saliva sample for the presence of immunoglobulin (which would confirm that the sample is indeed saliva).
