Job Description

Under the direction of the Deputy Commissioner for Programs and Strategic planning and Director of Workforce Development, the candidate will manage the "Working I.T. Out" program. This Department of Justice funded green technology initiative has been designed to 1) equip medium to high risk sentenced adult inmates with in demand green technology skills, 2) provide community based training, and 3) link program graduates to full time employment opportunities. The candidate will also lead, and serve as the agency's point of contact to a collaborative of external stakeholders including the New York City Department of Education, Strive International, and Hostos Community College.

- Manage the recruitment process and interview candidates at EMTC and RMSC.

- Implement practices and policies for the maintenance and evaluation of the program.

- Track all grant expenditures and prepare budgetary reports for federal audit.

- Develop relationships with the foundation community to identify resources to sustain the program following the expiration of grant funds.
