The preferred candidate possesses the following: 5 plus years of MS Windows Server and AD administration in a senior/lead role; MS certified engineer; EMC certified engineer; VMware certified engineer; Hardware knowledge and experience with HP servers, IBM blade servers, EMC SAN; Knowledge and experience administering a VMS (video management system) environment a plus; Knowledge and experience installing/configuring Genetec Omnicast, axis IP cameras and encoders a plus.
