Under supervision, the qualified candidate will perform bench, general shop and outside machinist work; set up and operate machine shop equipment and tools, such as engine lathes, shapers, milling machines, drill presses, planers and grinders; maintain, repair, test, overhaul, and replace all types of building systems equipment, such as: fans, blowers, exhausters, pumps and compressors; and perform related duties as assigned.</p>	
<p style="text-align:center"><b>Minimum Qualification Requirements</b></p> <p>1. Five years of full-time satisfactory experience acquired within the last fifteen years as a machinist; or</p> <p>2. At least two and one-half years of full-time satisfactory experience acquired within the last ten years as a machinist plus sufficient full-time experience as a machinist helper or an apprentice machinist, or training of a relevant nature acquired in an approved trade, technical or vocational high school, to make up the equivalent of the remaining required experience. Six months of acceptable experience will be credited for each year of helper or apprentice experience or approved trade or vocational high school, up to a maximum of two and one-half years.</p>	
<p style="text-align:center"><b>Residency Requirement</b></p> <p>New York City residency is generally required within 90 days of appointment. However, City Employees in certain titles who have worked for the City for 2 continuous years may also be eligible to reside in Nassau, Suffolk, Putnam, Westchester, Rockland, or Orange County. To determine if the residency requirement applies to you, please discuss with the agency representative at the time of interview.</p>
