Job Description

The New York City Department of Correction has openings for Plumber Helpers. Under direct supervision, the qualified candidates will assist plumbers with the installation, maintenance and repairs of piping for water, waste, soil and vent lines; assist with the installation of tanks, sprinklers and fire suppression systems; cut and thread pipes with hand or electrical operated tools; clean up work areas; and perform related duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualification Requirements

1. Three years of full-time satisfactory experience as a plumber's helper or apprentice plumber acquired within the last 12 years; or
2. Not less than one year of experience as described in "1" above plus sufficient training of a relevant nature acquired in an approved trade school, technical school or vocational high school to make up the equivalent of three years of acceptable experience. The apprenticeship must be recognized by the New York State Department of Labor, the U.S. Department of Labor or any apprenticeship council which is recognized by the U.S. Department of Labor. The schooling must be approved by a state's Department of Education or comparable agency. Six months of acceptable experience will be credited for each year of approved trade school, technical school or vocational high school.

Residency Requirement

New York City residency is generally required within 90 days of appointment. However, City Employees in certain titles who have worked for the City for 2 continuous years may also be eligible to reside in Nassau, Suffolk, Putnam, Westchester, Rockland, or Orange County. To determine if the residency requirement applies to you, please discuss with the agency representative at the time of interview.
