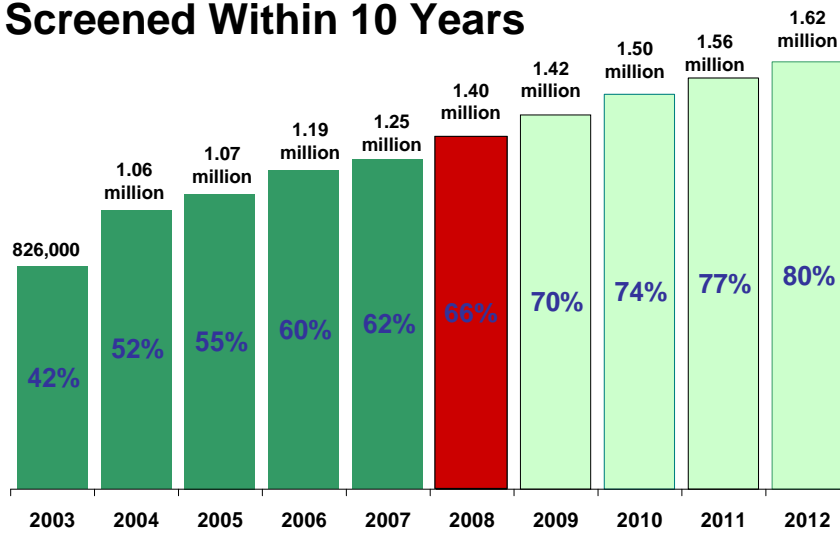

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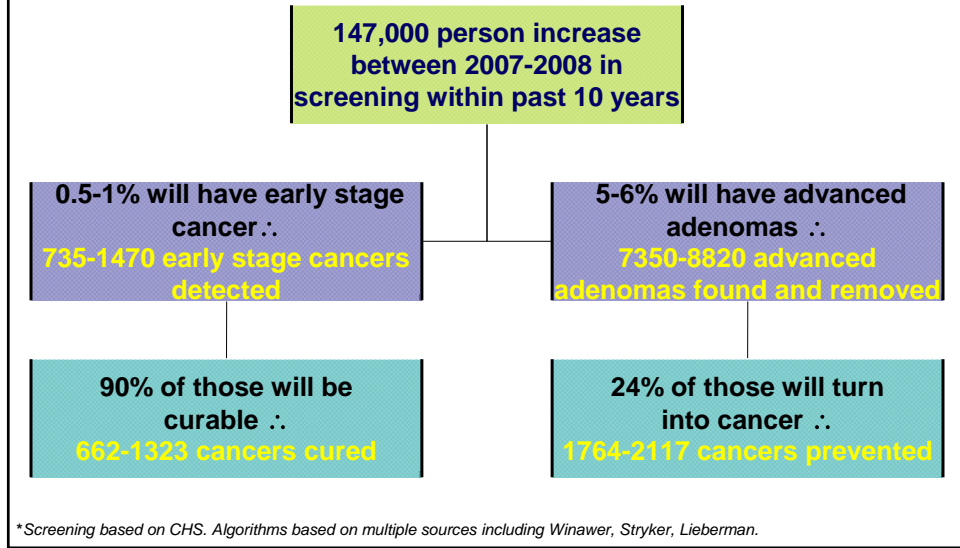


### Progress To Reach 2012 Goal Of 80% Screened Within 10 Years

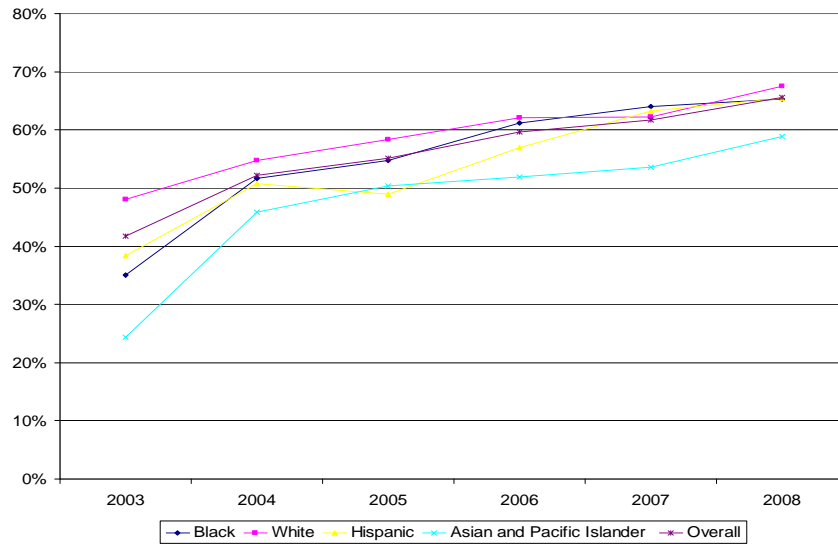

## CRC Cancers Prevented by Screening Increase in 2008

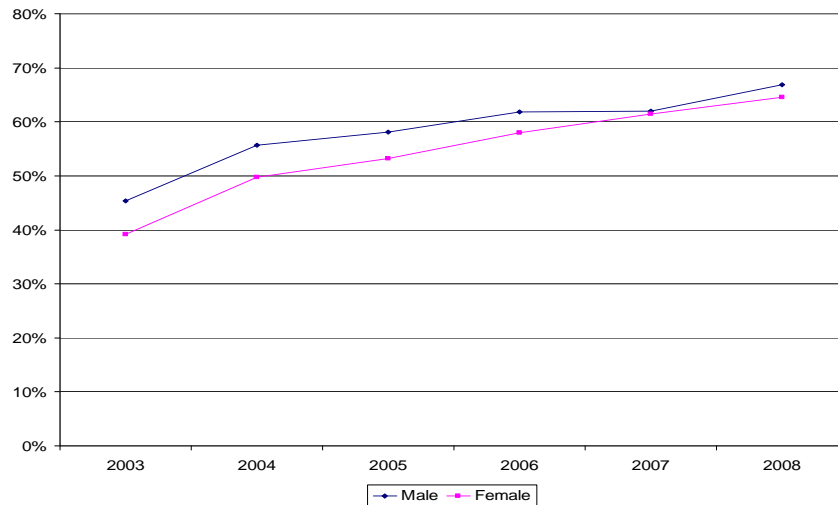


## Program Impact on Screening Disparities
