## Free Hepatitis Vaccinations/Testing:

The following NYC Department of Health STD clinics offer free hepatitis A and B vaccinations and hepatitis C testing. (There is no vaccine for hepatitis C.) All clinics offer hepatitis services Monday - Friday, starting at 8:30 am. There are no appointments, so come early.
