INTRODUCTION

To enhance early detection, prevention and medical care for hepatitis C (HCV) infection locally, the Hepatitis C Program of the New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH) established the South Bronx Hepatitis C Task Force in 2004. The Task Force is a consortium of concerned Bronx providers committed to increasing the number of HCV resources as well as access to resources for Bronx residents. One of the first needs identified by the Task Force was the development of a resource directory that would list HCV services to which providers could refer clients. Input from Task Force members, including the Steering Committee and the Resource Directory Subcommittee, guided the development of the directory.

A survey was mailed to over 1800 agencies or individual providers in the Bronx. Additional follow-up by e-mail and telephone was conducted for those who did not respond. Although multiple attempts were made to find the correct contact information, some providers may have been inadvertently missed. **If you know of any providers or agencies that should be included in this directory or if a correction needs to be made, please contact the Hepatitis C Program at the NYC DOHMH by calling 311.**

The continuum of services offered includes: (1) distribution of information and a flier to those released from jail to remind them to go to the community offices if a plan cannot be made pre-release; (2) outreach and education at daily orientation sessions to increase health awareness through education for all; (3) health education and risk reduction sessions in housing areas and in the schools; (4) transitional health care planning for those identified with chronic conditions (especially diabetes, cancer, hypertension, heart disease, uncontrolled asthma, STDs) who will need post-release follow-up; and (5) making appointments in the community with referrals, after-letters and follow-up when a release date to the community is certain.

Visiting Nurse Service of New York provides home care to people throughout the five boroughs and Westchester County. They collaborate with many hospitals, nursing facilities, clinics and physician practices to help meet the homecare needs of patients with hepatitis C and most other diagnoses. All care is provided in the patient's home and coordinated by the primary provider. They serve a large population of patients with hepatitis C and help them manage not only the hepatitis C but many of the co-morbidities they may have. They provide nursing homecare, home health aide services, physical therapy, occupational therapy, social work services and case management care. They also assist with medication management, hepatitis C nutrition counseling, and general nutrition counseling. Services are offered in English, Spanish, Russian and Chinese. The patient must require skilled care, and be self-directing or have back-up care provider. They accept Medicaid, Medicaid Managed Care, Medicare, ADAP, Third-party insurance. They also accept uninsured individuals and provide services free or on a sliding scale based on the client's income.

AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP)

Uninsured Care Programs (ADAP/ADAP Plus/APIC)
New York State Department of Health

The Uninsured Care Programs provide access to care for persons with HIV and AIDS who are uninsured or underinsured. The mission of the Program is to empower individuals to seek and access care and to provide a stable and timely funding stream to health care providers.

Covered services include out-patient primary care, limited dental and mental health services, lab tests, HIV-related prescriptions, home health care and insurance premium payments. Covered services specific to hepatitis include reimbursement for hepatitis C genotypic and viral load tests, pegylated interferon, ribavirin, vaccination and treatment for hepatitis A and B. There are no costs to participants for covered services.

Eligibility requirements for providers: Both individual physicians and Article 28 facilities are eligible to become ADAP plus providers. Article 28 providers must be also enrolled in the HIV Primary Care Medicaid Program. Private physicians must also be enrolled in the enhanced fees for physicians program through Medicaid. All providers must complete the Uninsured Care Programs Provider Application. For more information or to request an application please call 518-459-1641 and ask for provider enrollment.

Eligibility requirements for participants:

- New York State residency
- HIV-positive for ADAP and ADAP Plus
- Chronic medical dependency due to HIV illness for Home Care
- Income less than \$44,000 for a household of one; less than \$59,200 for a household of two; less than \$74,400 for a household of three or more.
- Liquid assets less than \$25,000


