RE: Citywide Immunization Registry (CIR) – 318KA-1 – 318KA Health Forms

This is an information update regarding the Bureau of Child Care Health Forms, which are required for attendees in your center. The New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene Citywide Immunization Registry (CIR), now allows physicians to use the Internet to look up and to update a child's immunization history. The computer printed version of the Child Care Health Form is an authorized 318KA-1 (New Admission) and 318KA (Follow-up Record) for children attending child care.

We have recently been made aware that some child care centers would not accept the CIR-generated 318KA-1 and 318KA Child Care Health Record. Please accept the computerized health form from the CIR when presented by the parent. This is an authorized form approved by the Bureau of Child Care at the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene.
