2010 – 2011 Influenza Vaccine Recommendations for Children

- All children 6 months through 18 years of age should receive annual influenza vaccination. Prioritize children 6 – 59 months of age and those children with chronic medical conditions.
- Vaccinate all children <9 years of age with 2 doses of influenza during the first season they are vaccinated to ensure maximum protection.
- For the 2010-11 influenza season, children ages 6 months through 8 years who did not receive at least 1 dose of an influenza A(H1N1) 2009 monovalent vaccine should receive 2 doses of a 2010-11 seasonal influenza vaccine, regardless of previous influenza vaccination history.
- Children ages 6 months through 8 years for whom the 2009-10 seasonal vaccine or influenza A(H1N1) monovalent vaccine history cannot be determined should receive two doses of a 2010-2011 seasonal influenza vaccine.
- Use preservative-free presentations for children 6 months to <3 years of age.

Estimate the number of vaccine doses needed for all VFC-eligible children for the 2010-2011 influenza season, and place your order. Ordering may be done by: 1) going to the CIR Online Registry, clicking on the VFC icon, and selecting the “Order Influenza Vaccine” tab or 2) completing and faxing this order form to (212) 676-2314. All orders are subject to approval. We anticipate shipping partial orders to make sure that all providers receive some vaccine to start vaccinations early.

Please note that because we cannot predict availability of specific presentations or brands, we request that you indicate the number of doses you anticipate needing for each of the specified groups listed below. The presentations and brands of injectable (inactivated) vaccine will be shipped based on availability. Preservative-free vaccines (single-dose presentations) will be preferentially shipped for use in children < 3 years of age.

Influenza Vaccine	Number of Doses Requested
6 – 35 months Injectable You may receive preservative-free 0.25 ml pre-filled syringes or multi-dose vials (contains preservative). We will only ship multi-dose vials for this age group if preservative-free vaccine is not available.	
3 – 18 years Injectable You may receive preservative-free 0.5 ml pre-filled syringes, single-dose vials, or multi-dose vials (contains preservative).	
2 – 18 years Live Intranasal (LAIV) (This vaccine is preservative-free.) We will only ship LAIV if you order it . We will not substitute LAIV for injectable vaccines.
