

MESSAGE FROM THE NEW YORK CITY MAYOR'S OFFICE TO COMBAT DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

Domestic violence is pervasive, with one in four women experiencing abuse in their lifetimes. The people of New York City voted to establish the Mayor's Office to Combat Domestic Violence (OCDV) as a permanent office of City government in November, 2001. Mayor Michael R. Bloomberg emphasized his commitment to this issue by appointing a Commissioner to head the office. In addition to developing policies and programs to assist domestic violence victims, OCDV coordinates the direct domestic violence services of 14 City agencies. During the Bloomberg administration, as a result of a coordinated community response to this issue, domestic violence crimes in New York City have decreased by 27%.

OCDV's first initiative, the Domestic Violence Response Teams (DVRT) was announced by the Mayor in May 2002 and focused on building an enhanced and coordinated response to domestic violence. Through DVRT, the City has been able to analyze the way services are delivered to our highest risk domestic violence victims and, in turn, develop concrete policy recommendations to enhance services for all victims across the City. To date, over 96% of the total participants have not reported any subsequent physical harm since entering the program.

The success of DVRT led in part to the creation of the New York City Family Justice Center in Brooklyn in summer, 2005. New York City was chosen as one of 15 communities out of 150 applicants to be part of a national Presidential initiative which is being funded in part from the United States Department of Justice Office on Violence Against Women. The Center is a one-stop service center for domestic violence victims, who may receive legal assistance and counseling, help with public assistance and shelter, file a police report or confide in a clergy member—all under the same roof, while their child plays in the next room. The partner organizations have the capacity to speak 20 languages, and Language Line telephones connected to interpreters for over 150 languages will be located throughout the Center.

All of OCDV's outreach materials and programs are in multiple languages, recognizing that 36% of New York City's population is foreign-born. Our OCDV/NYPD Language Line program for domestic violence victims equips patrol officers with telephones that instantly connect to an interpreter so that a victim can tell her story in her own language to an officer.

Since 70% of family related homicide victims had no known prior police contact, Mayor Bloomberg unveiled Project H.E.A.L. (Hospital Emergency Assistance Link) in May 2003, which increased the ability of City hospitals to identify victims, document their injuries through digital cameras and connect them with services, including legal assistance at monthly legal clinics.

The New York City Mayor's Office to Combat Domestic Violence is pleased to present the 2005 edition of the Resource Directory of Domestic Violence Services in partnership with the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene. INTRODUCTION

The City of New York Resource Directory of Domestic Violence Services provides comprehensive information on services available to domestic violence victims throughout the five boroughs. Information is organized alphabetically by organization name. An **index** listing domestic violence programs by **borough served** and **language accommodated** appears at the front of the Directory on pages 5-10. Pages 11-14 offer information on **police precincts, courts, district attorney offices and hospitals**. Commonly used **hotlines** are listed on page 99.

Outreach to public and private domestic violence service organizations occurred through mailings, conferences and other events. Organizations were cross-referenced with listings in more than ten other resource directories. Domestic violence organizations were invited to complete a survey describing their services. Organizations that submitted completed surveys by mail, facsimile or telephone are represented here.

Before referring a domestic violence victim to any of the organizations listed, it is advisable that you first contact the organization to ensure that appropriate services are available. In addition, you can contact **311** or the New York City's 24-hour, toll-free domestic violence hotline (**800-621-HOPE**) for up-to-date service information and assistance in over 150 languages.

If your organization would like to be included in future editions of the directory or you would like additional copies, please contact the Mayor's Office to Combat Domestic Violence at (212) 788-3156. Please note that an organization's inclusion in the directory does not imply endorsement by the City of New York. In addition, batterer intervention programs and other services for batterers that are included in this directory should be used with the understanding that such programs and services may or may not help to end the violence. These services should be used with caution and consideration for the safety of domestic violence victims.
