

DO NOT DRINK Water Order

For the consumers of
BREEZY POINT

This is very important information about your drinking water. Translate it, or speak with someone who understands it.

For all homes south of Rockaway Point Blvd to, and including, Oceanside Ave from Reid Ave Beach 201 St. west to Beach 204 St. and including graham place and 7th Ave to Beach 207 St.
And the heavily damaged area between Jamaica Walk and Ocean Ave and to the South of Oceanside Ave



Due to the possibility of unsafe water, consumers of the above noted water system are directed to do the following:

- **DO NOT** use water from the faucets for human consumption purposes but are advised to use bottled water or water from DEP's Water-On-the-Go station. Your tap water must NOT be used for drinking, making ice cubes, washing foods, brushing teeth or in any other activity involving consumption of water.
- DO NOT TRY AND TREAT THE WATER YOURSELF. Boiling, freezing, filtering, adding chlorine or other disinfectants, or letting water stand will not make the water safe.
- Please share this information with all other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (for example, visitors).

What happened? What is being done to fix the problem?

Water pipe damage due to Hurricane Sandy and recent building fires may have allowed contaminants to enter the water system. The water is being tested to determine if and when it is safe to drink.
