


New York City Bicycle Counts on a Single Weekday (7AM--7PM) at Selected Commuter Locations (1980-2008)



Notes:

1. Count is on a single mid-summer weekday from 7AM to 7PM except in 2006 and 2007.
2. The cyclist volume in 2006 is from a single weekday count in mid-September.
3. The cyclist volume in 2007 is an average of a single weekday count taken in May, July, August and September.
4. There is no data available for 12th Avenue in 1986 and the Williamsburg Bridge in 1991.
5. There is no data available from 1981-1984.
6. The Hudson River Greenway and Manhattan Bridge path opened to cycling in 2001.
7. For years prior to availability of the Hudson River Greenway, data for 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th avenues are shown as a proxy for this cycling market catchment.
8. The total count excludes 9th through 12th Avenues from 2001 to 2007 in order to maintain a conservative trend line.
