

New York City Department of Transportation Street Pavement Rating / Street Evaluation Data

Update schedule: Annually, with a status update each month

Abstract

The New York City Department of Transportation is responsible for keeping the city's streets in good repair. The Agency performs ongoing assessment of New York City streets. Ratings are based on a scale from 1 to 10, and results are grouped in the following categories:

- Good (%) - ratings of 8 to 10
- Fair (%) - ratings of 4 to 7 (*except on local streets where a 7 is good*)
- Poor (%) - ratings of 1 to 3.

RatingWord	Good, Fair, or Poor associated with the numeric rating.
RatingDate	The date the rating information was collected.
RatingFY_S	The Fiscal Year in which the rating was performed.
Shape_len	The Length of street segment, in miles, as calculated by GIS.

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
