



## Bus Rapid Transit

- Premium transit service using rubber-tired vehicles
- High capacity, low cost system to improve urban mobility

## Select Bus Service

- New York City's first phase of BRT











Bus Speeds in NYC vs. Other Cities



# **Trend: Bus Speeds Dropping**







# First Avenue/Second Avenue SBS First Ave/Second Ave SBS Corridor



8.5 miles from South Ferry to 125<sup>th</sup> Street

Currently served by M15 bus route

- 58,000 weekday riders
- Ridership has been decreasing due to slowing bus speeds

Within a ¼ mile:

- 537,000 residents
- 78% of households do not own a car
- 57% of residents commute by transit

Improved Service Increased hours of service and simpler service pattern


**Signal Priority** Transit signal priority between Houston Street and South Ferry

Fare Collection Proof-of-payment fare system with fare pre-payment





# First Ave/Second Ave SBS Features




#### Bus Lanes Offset bus lanes from 125<sup>th</sup> Street to Houston Street

#### **Bus Bulbs**

Bus bulbs extend sidewalk out to the bus lane, at BRT stations between 125<sup>th</sup> Street and Houston Street



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# Interaction with Second Ave Subway



During Construction NYCT and DOT are working in close coordination with Second Avenue Subway construction to eliminate SBS station/routing conflicts

In Operation Under both Phase 1 and full-build of SAS, passenger demand on the M15 will remain high


