


Rehabilitation of the Brooklyn Bridge

June 2010

CB 1 and 3 (Manhattan)

The New York City Department of Transportation is performing rehabilitation work on the Brooklyn Bridge ramps and approaches. Under this contract, the entire span will also be repainted to prevent steel corrosion. This work is commencing this spring and will continue until 2014. To accommodate the installation of the overhead protective shield, the western sidewalk on Pearl Street, between Frankfort Street and Avenue of the Finest, (***shown in the photo below right in the foreground***) will be closed. Abrasive blasting and repainting will then commence.



This closure will commence on Monday, June 14th 2010, and will be in effect Mondays through Saturdays. Pedestrians are encouraged to use the eastern sidewalk in this location. The western sidewalk will be reopened on or about Sunday, August 8th, 2010.
