Ramp “C” Parking *Kiss & Ride Entrance Ramp*

The New York City Department of Transportation (NYCDOT) has initiated a \$175M rehabilitation of the ramps leading into the St. George Ferry Terminal. Seven ramps linking Richmond Terrace to the terminal will be rehabilitated, the North Ramp will be reconstructed, architectural and lighting improvements will be made to all bus gates and painting of all structures will be completed.

Beginning **Tuesday, June 15, 2010**, all parking on **Ramp C** (the current entrance ramp to the South Municipal Parking Lot and the Kiss & Ride) will be discontinued. Ramp C will be prepared for upcoming two-way operation scheduled to commence on Tuesday June 22nd. Ramp C will accommodate two-way traffic during the reconstruction of Ramp D, the current Kiss & Ride exit ramp.

Ramp D is expected to reopen to traffic on or about March 15, 2011.

Beginning Tuesday, June 15th

Elimination of all parking on Ramp “C”
Entrance to the Kiss & Ride and South Municipal Parking Lot

The entrance ramp is being prepared for two-way operation on Tuesday, June 22nd

There will be no impact to ferry service during this work

NYCDOT will make every effort to minimize the amount of noise by using low-noise producing equipment. Active measures are taken by the contractor to reduce noise at its source, such as sound blankets, mufflers, sound screens, equipment placement and the use new “lower-noise producing” equipment. NYCDOT will perform continuous monitoring of the noise levels in the area during operations to minimize impacts and to ensure the quality of life for adjacent residents and workers.
