Component Rehabilitation of GREENPOINT AVENUE BRIDGE HBK1107

Community Boards: No.1 Brooklyn & No.2 Queens

August 2010

Beginning at 9 p.m. on Sunday August 29th, the New York City Department of Transportation (NYCDOT) will commence Phase I of the bridge deck rehabilitation of the Greenpoint Avenue Bridge. Project work includes the removal and replacement of the existing movable steel bridge deck and portions of the adjacent sidewalks. Phase 1 work requires closures of the Queens-bound travel lanes and Queens-bound (north side) sidewalk of the bridge. Traffic will operate in the Brooklyn-bound lanes with the assistance of Traffic Agents from 7a.m. to 7 p.m. and pedestrians will use the Brooklyn-bound (south side) sidewalk. This phase of the project will continue for 6 weeks and is anticipated to be completed by October 8th.

During the day Sunday August 29th, the contractor will uncover construction signs and install traffic barricades and safety devices throughout the project site in preparation for the start of work on Monday morning.
